

English

In our English lessons, we'll be moving on from Drawing Club and introducing Curious Quests to get children's creative juices flowing in their writing. We will be focusing on key texts such as 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea', 'The Mixed-Up Chameleon' and non-fiction books about animals around the world.

Maths

In maths, we will be mastering place value within 50, addition and subtraction within 20, length, height, mass and volume.

Science

In science, we will be comparing and grouping animals into mammals, birds, fish, amphibians and reptiles and finding out which animals are herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

Geography

We will be learning about animals that live in all 7 continents and the 5 oceans.

PSHE

Our topics in PSHE this term will focus on diversity and communities, and relationship education. More information about this subject will be sent out to parents in Spring 2.

PE

We'll be keeping active this term learning ball skills and striking and fielding games. Our PE days are Tuesday (outdoor) and Friday (indoor).

Art and Design Technology

In DT, we will be making an animal move in a picture using a slider or lever.

Computing

In our computing lessons, we will be learning how to move a mouse robot using controls and how to group data.

Music
