I am writing to inform you of a vacancy for the role of parent governor on our governing board.

The role of the governing board

The school's governing board is responsible for providing confident and strategic leadership, and creating robust accountability, oversight and assurance for the school's educational and financial performance. The board is passionate about education and committed to continuous school improvement to ensure the best possible outcomes for our pupils.

The role of a parent governor

As a parent governor, you'll work with the board to make sure it effectively carries out the duties referred to above. You'll also play a vital role in bringing a **parental perspective** to the governing board, but you're not there to speak 'on behalf' of the parent body.

To be a parent governor you should have:

- A strong commitment to the role and to improving outcomes for children
- Good inter-personal skills, curiosity, and a willingness to learn and develop new skills
- The specific skills required to make sure the governing board delivers effective governance

The governing board are particularly interested in candidates from an educational or financial background, although is not essential to the role.

Expectations of governors

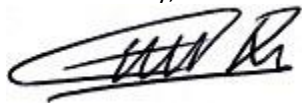
As a governor of our school there is an expectation that members attend 2 evening meetings a half term which are currently held on Tuesday's at 6:30pm. In addition, it is difficult to fulfil the role fully if you can't make a small amount of time throughout the academic year to come in whilst children are in school. This typically would be two or three visits which could be anything between an hour and a whole day. Outside of this professionalism and confidentiality is required to ensure the governing body carries out his statutory responsibilities.

If we receive more applications than there are vacancies, a secret ballot will be carried out. We will inform you closer to the time if we have to do this.
