

Design and Technology/ Art

Art - Children will focus on the artist William Morris, who is famous for his repeating patterns. Printing equipment will be used to create a final piece.

DT - Children will create puppets following the story of 'A Midsummer night's dream', using textiles and sewing skills. They will learn the different types of stitches.

Computing

Children will develop their understanding of manipulating digital 3D objects. They will rotate objects in 3 dimensions and combine skills to create their own name badge.

PE

Children will take part in Swimming on a Wednesday afternoon this term, as well as athletics.

Science

Furthering their knowledge on Electricity, children will make series circuits and record diagrams to represent these. They will also experiment with the impact of additional cells/alternative components.

Drama

In preparation for the end of year performance, children will practise their lines and rehearse on the stage considering voice projection and comedic timing.

French

Children will commence a topic on, 'The Vikings' where they will describe themselves and another person.

English
