

Art/ DT

In Art the children will be looking at creating water colour paintings inspired by Egyptian headdresses and Hieroglyphics. The children will be exploring colour and symbols from historic Egyptian stimulus.

In DT we will be backing our own shaduf this is an Egyptian lever used to collect water.

Computing

In Computing for Summer term the children will have the chance to explore programming systems and work on their coding skills. We will use different types of technology within school to support us to create our own animations.

In music this term the children will explore different genres of music and look at pitch, rhythm and tempo. Children will use different instruments to create a

RE - Good and Evil

This term in RE we will be looking at different Buddhist stories that explore the themes of good and evil. We will also look at Hindu stories that explore themes of peace.

Egyptians – Summer Term – Year 4



Maths

Place value

To be secure partitioning numbers to 10,000 and working with negative numbers.

Multiplication

Use place value knowledge to multiply and divide a number by 10 and 100. Learn how to multiply a 1-digit number by a 2 or 3-digit number using column method.

Addition and subtraction

Efficiency and estimation will be used while calculating addition and subtraction multi-step and word problems.

Fractions and decimals

Recognise and show, using diagrams, families of common equivalent fractions. Solve addition and subtraction calculations using fractions. Converting common fractions to the equivalent decimal. Adding and subtracting decimals using written methods.

Reasoning and problem solving

Children will be given many opportunities to explain how they know an answer is right and using problem solving skills.

Science-

Living things and their habitats.

Explore how a living thing is identified and extend their understanding of classification keys and how they are used.

Animals and Humans.

Children will explore the human body including the skeleton, teeth and the digestive system. We will also be looking at the food chain and different types of animals within that.

PSHE - Diversity and Difference

This unit looks at the importance of our identity and how we are similar and different to those around us. We will be learning about how to show respect to others and express who we are.

English

Non-Chronological Reports

Using lots of non-fiction texts about our topic Egyptians and independent research the children will write a report all about the life of Egyptians, including the Pyramids. We will be using all the skills we have learnt so far this year to make our writing interesting.

Letter writing

The children will create a letter addressed to Tutankhamun. They will look at the features of letter writing and practice these skills to publish a final piece of writing.

Editing and improving

We are always working on improving our work by editing. Children will be continuing to learn the skills necessary to identify where they can improve their own work.
