Dear parents/carers of year 2 children,

As part of our Summer term topic 'Ready, Steady, Grow!', we have organised a visit to **Sacrewell Farm** on **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June**.

During the day children will take part in two workshops; '**From Cows to Carrots**' where children will learn what plants need to grow and how animals rely on plants for nutrition and to stay healthy. We will visit the kitchen garden and a paddock of animals to consolidate learning. '**Seasonal Fruit and Vegetables**' Where Children get to visit the kitchen garden and pick some fresh produce before washing, preparing and eating it. Also, children will get the opportunity to take a tour of the farm and enjoy the amazing play area.

Year 2 will need to arrive at school promptly for 8:40am as we will be leaving at 9:00am on a coach. Children will arrive back to school before home time so will be collected from their classrooms as normal. We will be spending the whole day outdoors and therefore all children will need to bring weather appropriate shoes such as trainers or comfy wellies and a waterproof coat.
