Dear Year 3 parents/carers,

As part of our topic 'The Stone Age', we have organised a visit to **Flag Fen in Peterborough** on **Friday 28th November 2025**. At Flag Fen children will explore and experience how people lived and survived in prehistory, including traditional skills, materials and processes. Children will develop an understanding of the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, they will experiment with wattle and daub building methods and create some prehistoric art. Children will learn how Stone Age people hunted and see the types of houses they lived in.

Year 3 will need to arrive at school promptly for 8.40am as we will be leaving at 9am on a coach. Children will arrive back to school before home time so will be collected from their classrooms as normal. We will be spending the whole day outdoors in the gardens and therefore all children will need to bring an outdoor pair of shoes such as wellies or old trainers. Wellies or old trainers will be changed into when we arrive on site so please provide a carrier bag for these outdoors shoes to go in on the return coach trip. All children will require a waterproof coat and warm clothes. If the weather is due to be warm and sunny, you might like to bring a sun hat. All children will require a nut free packed lunch and water bottle from home for this trip. No fizzy drinks are allowed. Please ensure all your children's belongings are named.

We are asking for a contribution of **£13 per child** to cover the cost of this trip. If you would like your child to go on this fun and exciting trip, please use ParentPay to make your contribution and give permission by **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> November**. We would very much like this trip to take place and hope you will contribute, however if we don't receive sufficient funds we may have to cancel the experience.
