Dear Parents / Carers

We are pleased to inform you that a visit to Verulamium Museum in St Albans, has been confirmed for Thursday 20th November 2025 for both Year 4 classes. It will take place during school hours but we do ask that your child is at school for 08:40 to ensure we can leave promptly at 8:50, returning at 3:15, with children released from their classroom door shortly afterwards.

St Albans was an important city in Roman Britain and while we are at the museum the children will take part in a session run by museum staff to explore artefacts found in archaeological surveys of the area as well as completing a museum tour. We will also be able to see the remains of a Roman mosaic that was unearthed at a site nearby in Verulamium park and we will walk to the ruins of the Roman city walls.

Please be aware that part of the trip involves a walk and we would therefore ask that you consider footwear carefully and wear appropriate clothing for the time of year including a waterproof coat with a hood.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink. The cost of this trip is £11.00 which includes the cost of the museum entrance, education session and transport and is being subsidised by the school. Please pay and give permission via ParentPay by Friday 7th November.
